


Installation of the FootSwitch V7.3.5 foot switch


Start the setup and install your new foot switch as follows.



Setup:

1. Select your foot **switch type** on the left.
2. Open the **Mouse function** on the right
3. On the right, first select "**Left Mouse Button**" and then also "**Middle key**" and "**Right key**"
4. Select the respective "**Mouse Button**" from the **drop-down menu**, "**Left Mouse Button**", "**Middle Mouse Button**" and "**Right Mouse Button**".
